- It is often said that the city's name comes from the Quechua phrase "Ari, quepay" which means "Yes, here" which is said to have been the response of the Fourth Inca - Mayta Capac - upon seeing the site of the great city.
- Nowadays it is assumed that the name derives from Aymara language- "ari" (peak) + "kipa" (locative) and means something like "near the mountain" in reference to the nearby volcanoes: Misti and Chachani..
- Arequipa is influenced by Spanish colonial ideas and architecture.
- While visiting Arequipa, our package allows you to visit the most popular tourist attractions: Plaza de Armas, Temple and plaza of San Francisco, the Convento de Santa Catalina and more.

After venturing through the beautiful Arequipa the next excursion includes a trip to the Colca Canyon—deeper than the Grand Canyon. This package is ideal if you're seeking an adventure.

First Day:

Airport transfer to Hotel

City Tour

Includes tour of the Plaza de Armas, Temple and plaza of San Francisco, passage of the Cathedral Basilica, church leaders of Compañía de Jesús, and a visit to the Convento de Santa Catalina.

Second Day:

Colca Canyon

Chivay:08:00 a.m. This tour begins with the pickup of our passengers from their hotels to start the journey to the Gran Canyon del Colca. This journey goes through Yura which is located behind the snowy Chachani volcano, where you can also appreciate the Misti volcano which is also near in sight.

We will stop in Pampa Cañahuas, plainly located in the vicinity of the pool of Aguada Blanca. Here you can see the different species of South America—llamas, vicunas, alpacas...

Our next stop will be at Pata Pampa, the highest elevation at 4,800 m.

Here you will find the Mirador de Arequipa where you can appreciate the majestic volcanoes: Hualca Hualca, Sabancaya, Ampato. After these spectacular views, we will once more continue our journey to Chivay. Reception and accommodation in the hotel of your choice with private bathrooms and hot water is included. Third Day:

Chivay- Mirador de la Cruz del Condor- Arequipa

A continental breakfast is included at the indicated time and then an immediate departure to the Mirador de la Cruz del C6ndor.

Here you can observe the profound beauty of the Colca Canyon and enjoy the flight of the Condors—the lords and the masters of this great Canyon.

Returning, we will visit the different pueblos of this region: Pinchollo, Maca, Yanque. You will have breakfast in Chivay and in the evening we will return on the same route to Arequipa.
