- No one knows exactly why Machu Picchu was built at the height of the Incan Empire. It is known that the Spaniards never made it this far, because it's still standing.
- The only remains found were those of women and children, so one theory is that this is a sanctuary where women and children were sent when the men were off fighting.
- While visiting Cuzco you will be able to embrace the Incan culture that many people still practice to this day.
- Our package allows you to visit all the important sites in the city of Cuzco, and all the picturesque ruins in the Sacred Valley. A must see for the ultimate Peru experience.

First Day: Airport transfer and / or Terminal - Hotel, free morning and afternoon

City Tour: At the indicated time we will have an excursion that includes: Cathedral: Built within the years of 1560 y 1664 and constructed of large blocks of red granite. The facade is of the Renaissance style, and inside you can see the altar worked in silver, which is home to great treasures in Cuzco with jewelry and paintings from the colonial era.

Koricancha: It was built in the time to devote Incan worship to the sun.

Kenko: Consists of rocky stairs and demonstrates ceremonial altars. It was used as an oracle for worship or for religious ceremonies.

Sacsayhuaman: It is a colossal building made up of large stones-limestone used in most of the building, and one of which weighs 128 tons. A single stone on this building can measure 9X5m.

Puca Pucara: This point could have been a point of control and storage of production in the valley nearby, but looks like a military compound. It is located 6Km from the city of Cuzco.

Tambomachay: Located 7km from the city. Made up of finely assembled stone buildings with aqueducts running water from a spring whose origin is unknown, and pouring into a fountain called the Bathroom of the Inca.

Second Day: Tour of the sacred valley

At the indicated time, we will stop at your hotel for passengers, and then begin our tour with a visit to the most important archaeological sites in the valley:

Pisac: A picturesque colonial and mestizo town, which grabs the interest and appreciation of many tourists. Here we will stop to enjoy a lunch buffet at the restaurant—La Carreta.

Ollantaytambo: The people of this region live in their ancestral homes where they have changed the tile roofs and maintain the original Incan streets.

Chincho: You go through this town to arrive to Machu Picchu.

Third Day: Tour of Machu Picchu

- We begin with the pick up of the passenger from their hotel on the tourist bus and go to the pueblo of Ollantaytambo. Upon arrival you will catch a vistadome train to the pueblo of Aguas Calientes. The train ride lasts approximately 2 hours and during the travel period you will appreciate the spectacular natural scenery. Then once again, you will get on a bus to Machupicchu, where you will have a guided tour for a little over two hours. Finally you will return to the pueblo of Aguas Calientes to eat lunch. In the evening you will catch a train back to Ollantaytambo and by bus to Cusco.
- **Fourth Day:** Free day tour of Cuzco and shopping. It also has a lot to see in and of itself. There are lots of temples and ruins around the city and the shopping is great!
