

## Puno



- The city of Puno originates from the Tiahuanaco cultura and best exemplifies the Aymara towns that exist between Peru and Bolivia. The Inca have a long standing presence in this region as do the Spanish, who left and important colonial architecture.
- Today, Puno is the capital of folkloric Peru. The city is most known for the Fiesta de la Virgen de la Candelaria, Lake Titicaca, the highest navigable lake in the world, and Uros Island.
- Titicaca is notable for a population of people who live on the Uros, a group of 42 or so artificial islands made of floating reeds.
- These islands have become a major tourist attraction for Peru, drawing excursions from the lakeside city of Puno-Visit Puno!

### First Day: Tour to Sillustani

We initiate the tour by picking up our passengers in their respective hotels, and heading to Yanamayo. This is a Mirador that overlooks the region around us, and here you can take pictures. Following these miraculous views, we will continue our trip for another 34 km and while doing so we will stop in Antucolla—a district characterized by their agriculture and cattle. The guide will then give you some background information on this area and about the different cultures: Pucara, Kolla, Tiuhanaku, and Incas as we begin our escalation to different archeological complexes. You will become familiar with different spiritual sightings such as the Chullpas funeral, slab galleries, monoliths, buried tombs, intiwatana, and ritual bathing of the Incas. Finally we will visit the Museum of the Site

Here we will find what these cultural groups are exhibited such as: potteries of Tiahuanaku Kolla and the Incas, pieces of ceramics, artifacts, necklaces, human skeletons, and stone instruments. We will then return to the city and drop off our passengers to their respective hotels. 01 night accommodation

### Second Day: Uros Islands - Amantani - Taquile

We will begin our tour by picking up our passengers from their hotel to a port where we will catch a motor boat to the Islands of Uros—the place where we will remain for by 40 minutes. We will be introduced to the different dwellings of the people who conserve the culture of this area. Our trip will continue by water for another 02 hours until we arrive to the Amantani. Here the native people greet the tourists very politely by offering some drinks then taking them to where they will be staying.

They will also serve lunch—food typical to this island, and followed by muña or eucalyptus tea. In the evening we will visit the ceremonial temples of Pacha Tata, Pacha Mama and its branches of: Ukupacha, Kaipacha, and Hananpacha. From the top of these temples you can appreciate the eastern and western mountain ranges, as well as the Island of the Sun, Island of the Moon, and Copacabana, Bolivia. While descending the temples we will visit the artisan centers, then we return to our lodging for dinner. Here the native people mount a folkloric rock where they will sing and dance. 01 night accommodation on the Amantani Island.

### Third Day: Amantani Island– Taquile

The natives will again offer us a typical breakfast so that we can continue our tour of the Amantani Island, then travel to the Island of Taquile which lasts 5 minutes. We will continue this amazing journey to the pueblo of Taquile and rest there for half an hour. Here we can appreciate the Tiahuanacuense native dwellings and later the artesian centers. The importance of this trip is to experience the living lifestyle of the Taquileña, and the religious and cultural customs of this region. You will have free time for two hours so you can look around and take pictures of some of the miraculous sites. Finally we will return to our hotels in Puno and arrive there at about 4:00 pm.
