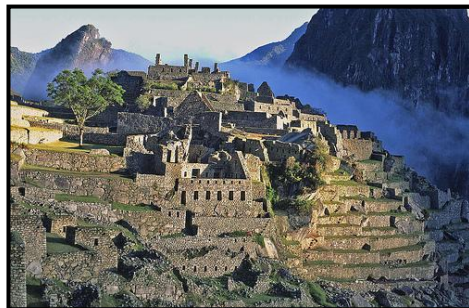

- Cusco is the historic capital of the Inca Empire and was declared a World Heritage Site in 1983 by UNESCO
- While visiting Cuzco you will be able to embrace the Incan culture that many people still practice to this day.
- Our package allows you to visit all the important sites in the city of Cuzco, and all the picturesque ruins in the Sacred Valley. A must see for the ultimate Peru experience.

### Day One:

In the morning there will be pick-up at the hotel to get on the bus that will take us 82 Km out through Chinchero and Ollantaytambo. After driving we will meet up with our professional guides that will ensure a safe and successful trip. Here we will begin our walk. The first day will be a very relaxing and easy walk. The walk will allow us to see the beautiful landscape of the snow covered one "La Veronica" We will walk to the outskirts of the river Vilcanota arriving at the archaeological group of Llactapata, where we have lunch. After lunch we will continue our walk to Wayllabamba where will camp. Duration: Approximately 5 hours

### Day Two:

After breakfast we will begin our second day of our walk—perhaps the most difficult walk yet since we will need to walk up to warmyhuãusca, 4200 meters above sea level. Warmyhuãusca, the highest altitude in the Incan trail, we will be able to enjoy the spectacular views of the snowy mountains that will surround us. podremos gozar de una nueva vista panorámica hacia los nevados que rodean el abra, After lunch we will begin our descent to the Pacaymayo Valley. Here we will set our second camp out.

Duración: Approximately 6 to 7 hours.

#### Day Three :

Early in the morning we will again return to the trail. Half an hour after we hike, we will find ourselves at the archeological site of Runkuracay. From this point on, the trail is paved. This paving is unique because it demonstrated the Inca engineering—at some places the paving is about 2 meters wide. We will visit Sayacmarca, a beautiful complex, where we will go through a tunnel that goes through the mountain, so that we can arrive to Phuyupatamarca. After reaching this point, the Inca trail will be completely different because we will have reached the jungle. Everything will be flourishing with vegetation and you will see the richness of the soil with so many plants. We will arrive to Wiñaywayna where we will have our third and final campout.

Duration: 7 to 8 hrs.

#### Day Four:

We will wake up early in the morning to eat breakfast and continue our walk on the trail. While arriving to Intipunku (Door of the Sun), we will start seeing Machu Picchu, and here you will see a very beautiful and unique view of this beautiful city. Because it will still be early morning, we will be able to see the most picturesque view with the sunrise.

We will go down to Machu Picchu and have a guided tour around this city. After the tour you will have free time to explore Machu Picchu by yourself. In the evening we will take a train back to Cuzco and be transferred to your hotel.
