- It is often said that the city's name comes from the Quechua phrase "Ari, quepay" which means "Yes, here" which is said to have been the response of the Fourth Inca - Mayta Capac - upon seeing the site of the great city.
- Nowadays it is assumed that the name derives from Aymara language- "ari" (peak) + "kipa" (locative) and means something like "near the mountain" in reference to the nearby volcanoes: Misti and Chachani..
- Chachani is the highest of the volcanoes near the city of Arequipa in southern Peru. Its name means "skirt" in Quechua. Because of the very low precipitation in the Arequipa area, Chachani does not have a permanent ice cap or glaciers.
- The ascent to the summit is therefore non-technical, and can be attempted by inexperienced climbers. Climbing Chachani is popular with tourists.

#### Day1:

At the indicated time in the morning, we will leave Arequipa and start our journey up the Chachani. At 5250 meters up, we will stop for dinner and camp there. The camping equipment will be provided.

#### Day2:

Early in the morning we will have breakfast then continue going up the Chachani. By mid-day we will be at the top where you can enjoy a spectacular view of the surrounding city. After reaching the top of this huge volcano, we will start our way back down the Chachani and be back in Arequipa by evening.
